In addition, theories and practices on testing reading, writing, listening, speaking and overall language ability are discussed. Basic measuring procedures for test construction and evaluation would be introduced. Real or simulated test data are to be used for class instruction and students exercises, sessions for software application are integrated with some specific topics. Through this course, students are expected to well understand the essential principles of language testing, could calculate some basic test statistics using SPSS or other software.</p>
