* Description	As a literature-related course for the seniors, it uses classics or excerpts representative of particular literature trends in German-speaking countries to increase fun in reading and to instill in students background knowledge about Germany and its culture. The teaching materials, i. e., excerpts from modern German novels, poetry, essays and drama excerpts, are arranged in time sequence and introduced together with literary terms. Meanwhile, the teachers must be conscious of the students' capabilities about reading, listening, speaking, writing and translating. The curriculum should be changed into a comprehensive appreciation of the literature, but also will improve the language skills				

of the students. The goal is to develop students' interests in this field by making creative use of the materials, thus preparing students for independent-study of the German literature.
